Internship Activity for Magik Theatre

Reporting to the Director of Education and working closely with Magik's teaching artists, our intern will support Magik's summer camp programs and oversee the curriculum implementation of classes.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Assisting in preparing teaching supplies
- Assisting in preparing classrooms
- Check-in students each morning
- Leading a group warm-up with the entire camp each session
- Providing daily progress reports to parents
- Conducting breakout sessions in order to coach students and help them complete tasks

In addition to supporting classroom instruction, the intern will also serve as the Production Manager for the following student performances:

- *Myth, Magic, and Farce: A Jump-Start's performance of Le Griffon at Carver Little Theatre
- *Harry Potter Fan Film
- *Murder Mystery at Estancia

Additional duties include assisting with A World of Magik, a city-wide outreach initiative at Haven for Hope, Promesa Academy, Edgewood ISD, and other organizations.

The internship runs from June 6 to August 12, 2022. The ideal candidate will have some experience with the performing arts and an interest in arts education. 40 hours a week. May include some weeknights and weekends. Since you will work closely with minors, Magik will run a background check.

This paid internship is covered through the Bexar County Arts Internship Fund. Total compensation for this internship is \$3,500, paid in increments during the internship.

 - Why are you interested in an internship with Magik Theatre?
 - What strengths would you bring to the internship?
 - What are your career goals and how would a Magik Theatre internship assist you in attaining those goals?
