PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: The Magik Theatre is the number one choice for arts education and entertainment for many families in San Antonio. As San Antonio's professional theatre company, our commitment to the community is paramount. To this end, our education program serves over 1,000 students each year and reaches out to students of all ages and backgrounds. Interns are essential team members in this success.

The Magik Theatre presents our annual Winter Mini Classes for students ages 3 to 17. Classes take place at one location: The Magik Theatre, located at 420 S. Alamo Street in Hemisfair Park. Winter Mini Class lasts three days each week over two weeks and has a class-specific theme that is used to teach The Magik Theatre's core values of creativity, confidence, and teamwork.

INTERN DESCRIPTION:

Interns must be available and willing to work for a full day for the duration of the specific program sessions. All major scheduling conflicts (vacations, alternative employment) must be noted within the original application to be honored without a deduction in pay.

Interns are paid bi-weekly, while High School Internships are available on an unpaid basis. Ideal candidates should be able to commit to the entire Winter session which runs for 3 days two weeks, from December 21-23 and December 28-10. Interns will work a regular schedule of 8:45am-3:30pm, Monday-Wednesday.

INTERN DUTIES INCLUDE:

- Supporting lead teaching artists in daily activities
- Assisting in the needs of the Administrative Staff, Specialty Teachers, and Lead Teachers
- Organizing supplies and taking inventory of supplies needed
- Opportunity to teach mini-focus classes in skills such as vocal projection, stage presence, improvisation and other theatre/arts skills as determined by the skill sets of the staff
- Providing additional supervision to students during lunch
- Assisting in the final performances and after each session

We are also looking for Specialty teachers in the areas of Acting, Musical Theatre Dance, Performance, Film, and Musical Direction.
