

Development & Sales Coordinator Internship - The Magik Theatre is looking to expand its marketing and fundraising outreach to family-friendly businesses in San Antonio, Bexar County, and South Texas. Working directly with Magik's CEO, Director of Sales and Marketing, and the Development Manager, he/she/they will learn to leverage Magik's 100,000 patrons to gain wider support from the business community. The goal of this internship is to coordinate between Magik's marketing and development departments in order to develop and implement a small business campaign and "working-parents' group" to reach new supporters of The Magik Theatre.

At the end of the internship, the candidate will have completed a database of potential business partners as well as designed the print and digital materials for a direct mail and social media campaign to launch at the end of his/her tenure.

Other Tasks Include:

- Acting as the primary liaison in researching, connecting, and creating meaningful partnerships between The Magik Theatre, regional small to mid-sized businesses, and working professionals.
- Creating a comprehensive database of potential donors and business partners for use during direct mail and social media campaigns.
- Crafting a business outreach plan that can be implemented during the 2019-2020 season.
- Seeing the life-cycle of a grant from researching a potential donor, arranging a meeting, and applying for funding.
- To assist in daily tasks of the Magik as they arise.

The ideal candidate has excellent written and oral communication skills, an interest in the intersection between business administration and the arts, data management, and marketing. Must be a full-time student at either a university or college in Bexar County or a full-time student at a university elsewhere but a resident of Bexar County.

The internship runs from June 3 to August 9, 2019.

40 hours a week. May include some weeknights and weekends.

This paid internship is covered through the Bexar County Arts Internship Fund. Total compensation for this internships is \$3,500, paid in increments during the internship.
