

Magik Theatre Teacher

Position Title: Part-time Theatre Instructor

Program Description: Teaching Artists will instruct students in secondary classrooms 6-8 in public schools Monday- Friday. Hours will depend on school placement. We teach theatre in order to transform lives. Using a curriculum based on Social Emotional Learning, we build community, foster joy, uplift diversity, and increase literacy across multiple subject areas. Our theatre classes provide a safe space for students who have experienced trauma to express themselves in a healthy way through drama activities.

Training: Teachers will be trained through the Magik Theatre and SAISD Paraprofessional Development.

Applicants must have the following:

- High School Diploma
- Have experience teaching and/or working with children in this specific age group.
- Have experience writing and executing curriculum.
- Have a background in theatre, music, dance & education.

Preferred Qualifications:

Bachelor's or master's degree in theatre education or related field.

Time Commitment:

In addition to specific class schedules, Teaching Artists are expected to commit to a two-day mandatory training with Magik, attend SAISD Paraperfessional Development Trainings, attend school meetings, attend meetings with the Magik's Education Department, and 1 hour of lesson prep per day. Classes will require an end-of-semester sharing which may fall outside of the typical instructional day. UIL One Act Play participation will also be required except for extenuating circumstances.

Stipend: Teaching Artists in residency earn an hourly wage of \$25/hr for teaching hours and preparation hours with a 1:1 ratio.
