SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:

The Magik Theatre is the number one choice for families and schools in San Antonio for arts and culture programs. The Magik Theatre holds Academy classes and camps year round. These programs take place at The Magik Theatre, schools, and community organizations. Magik's classes have a specific thematic focus while teaching core values of collaboration, communication, creativity, and critical thinking. Magik's outreach program was created to serve the community of San Antonio by providing educational opportunities that go beyond the walls of our facility. Our partnership with Haven for Hope provides theatre classes and a safe space for students who have experienced trauma to express themselves in a healthy way through drama activities. We are looking for Teaching Artists to collaborate with Haven for Hope Staff who are dedicated to Arts Education and have a passion for students who have experienced trauma to help build confidence and explore the world of theatre.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Implement US arts integrated curriculum and/or create lessons to support social and emotional development through theatre arts instruction.
- Highly skilled in at least one of the following theatre arts disciplines; acting, improvisation, playwriting, movement, vocal production or technical theatre production.
- Experienced at guiding students to full-scale culminating presentations.
- Allow students to "share out" what they have learned and reflect on their learning.
- Plan and establish a safe learning environment for all participants and artists.
- Planning & preparing for and leading daily activities.
- Participate in pre-plan and post-planning meetings and training with co-teaching artists, Magik staff, and or mentors.
- Document class agenda and successes and challenges for each session and share with Administrative staff.
- Report weekly with Administrative staff with any concerns including lessons, learning, attendance, and facility issues.
- Submit participant attendance and sign in sheets, and other documents in a timely manner in accordance with the Administrative deadlines.
- Adhere to Magik guidelines & policies and to those of the facility, reporting any incidents or problems.

- Be a positive role model to students, Magik staff, organization and fellow Teaching Artists.
- Identifies and responds to any child who is experiencing a problem or crisis to ensure that they are safe and communicate to a Haven for Hope staff onsite and aware them of the situation and able to respond with appropriate measures.
- Respond to any emergency situation promptly and contact Haven for Hope's onsite staff.
- The ability to treat every child with respect and understand that each child's actions may be due to underlying trauma.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED:

- The ideal candidate will have a background in theatre and education. Proficient in curriculum building and teaching. Familiarity with working in trauma based organizations or environments.
- Teaching Artist will go through a Background check, CPR/First Aid training, Curriculum and Trauma training & Covid testing.
- Haven for Hope work badge, parking pass and tour will be provided.
- This position will work evenings 5:00PM-7:00PM and must be available. One hour of prep and one hour of instructional time.
