### Welcome!

#### Dear Friends,

Welcome back to Magik! We are so excited for you to join us for the second show of our 2021-22 season, *Snow White*. Live theatre creates transformational experiences for young people - something that many children have had less access to due to the pandemic. The past 18 months have shown us that real-life, in-person, tangible experiences are crucial to understanding the world around us, which directly correlates with our sense of compassion, identity, curiosity, and imagination.

We originally produced *Snow White* in November and December of 2020, when kids were stuck in remote learning and a vaccine for COVID-19 was still in the distant future. Snow White herself is also stuck – imprisoned by a vain stepmother who couldn't bear anyone being more beautiful than her. Locked in her castle, Snow White yearns to go outside to look at the trees, listen to the birds, and watch the light in the sky change. When she does escape, she is given shelter by seven strangers who are sympathetic to her plight. Fairy tales continue to endure because they can show us that the values of the past are not so different from our values now.

This version of *Snow White* features two actors playing all of the roles. Playwright Greg Banks said, "In a funny way, it's quite nice for the audience. For the audience to see Snow White play the Stepmother, to realize she can be more than one kind of thing, that people can be more than one thing." We hope it might inspire your family to adapt your favorite stories using the transformational potential of your imaginations, the same way that Snow and Dwarf 4 share their story with you.

We will see you at our next production, Ella Enchanted!

### About Snow White From Rosa Gardner's Notes

Snow White is a show I know well, having played the character of Snow White myself in Magik's production in 2020 then serving as Associate Director for the tour production earlier this year. Because I am so familiar with the script, I had no doubt it would be an exciting story to tell! Its themes of friendship, sticking up for others, and opening our homes to those who need shelter and safety are particularly relevant in today's world.

This adaptation of Snow White was an especially fun challenge because of the sheer number of characters that the two actors must play on their own. While adding costume pieces can help the audience know who's who, that alone isn't enough-- we had to ask ourselves questions like: how does this character move? How do they speak? What is their view on what is happening in this scene? Do they have enough individual qualities to make it clear that they are different from each other?

Thankfully, theatre is a collaborative effort: these talented actors brought their own unique capabilities and ideas, and we worked together to find where each character would live in their bodies and voices. It was like a puzzle to solve! It's been very exciting to see it come together.

I am very proud of this cast and this production. I hope you enjoy the show as much as we enjoyed making it come alive!

### Anthony Runfola Artistic Director



**Anthony Runfola** (*Artistic Director*) is in his second season with Magik and is excited to be leading the company into its bright future.

His directing credits at Magik include Snow White, Maddi's Fridge, and Señor Tortuga. This season he will direct Ella Enchanted. Other recent productions include The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe, Wonderland: Alice's Rock and Roll Adventure, Goodnight Moon, Charlotte's Web,

*Eric and Elliot, The Neverending Story,* and the world premieres of *Interrupting Vanessa* and *Rock the Presidents* (national tour). His production of *Schoolhouse Rock Live!* will be on its second national tour throughout 2021 and '22. He has been a guest artist at theatres and colleges throughout the country including Black Theatre Troupe, Actors Theatre of Phoenix, Teatro Bravo, Stray Cat Theatre, Phoenix Theatre, Gammage/ASU Public Events, Scottsdale and Mesa Community Colleges, Geva Theatre Center, and Seattle Children's Theatre.

Prior to arriving at Magik, Anthony was the Director of Production at Childsplay in Tempe, Arizona, where he oversaw the production of over 150 plays and musicals during his 20-year tenure. Additionally, he led the development of *El Puente* Festival and was a founding co-chair of the company's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion committee. In 2010, he founded the Sustainable Stagecraft Initiative researching and developing sustainable practices for theatrical production. He has been invited to speak on the subject at conferences throughout the nation.

He is a founding member of Upstairs Theatre Company in Tucson, AZ and served as the company's artistic director until 2001. In 2015, he was accepted into the inaugural cohort of ArtEquity. Theatre Communications Group selected him as one of 50 U.S. theatre practitioners to participate in *I Am Theatre*, a web series celebrating pivotal moments in the lives of theatre-makers. He is an alumnus of the Lincoln Center Theater Directors Lab and Director's Lab West at the Pasadena Playhouse.

Along with his family, he is a recent transplant to San Antonio (arriving in 2020) and is looking forward to *finally* getting to explore the city!

**Rosa Gardner** (*Director*) is incredibly grateful to be part of bringing the story of *Snow White* to the community! Since moving to San Antonio five years ago, Rosa has performed in over 15 Magik productions. #### HOW MAGIK IS KEEPING YOU SAFE

- All Magik staff are fully vaccinated against Covid-19 and will wear masks at all times during your visit.
- Magik's HVAC system has been updated with a UV purification system to reduce all airborne pathogens.
- Portable air scrubbers are in place in the lobbies where patrons naturally congregate (such as near concessions)
- High touch points and other surfaces will be sanitized frequently throughout your visit.
- Masks will be required of all patrons over the age of 24 months, regardless of vaccination status. Masks may only be removed while eating or drinking concessions, if available.
- Temperatures will be taken upon entry.
- The theatre is limited to 30% capacity to ensure physical distancing between each party. Every other row will be left clear and there will be at least two empty seats between each part.
