Program Description: The Magik Theatre is the number one choice for many families in San Antonio for arts education and entertainment. As San Antonio's only professional theatre company our commitment to the community is paramount. To this end, our education program serves over 2,000 students each year and reaches out to students of all ages and backgrounds. Teaching Artists and Interns are essential team members in this success.

Each summer The Magik Theatre operates *Camp Showbiz* for students aged 3 years to 17 years. We typically serve around 750 campers per summer. These programs take place at The Magik Theatre at 420 S. Alamo Street 78205 in Hemisfair Park and/or our Northside location at 5359 Casa Bella 78249. Each of the classes has a specific thematic focus while teaching The Magik Theatre's core values of creativity, confidence and teamwork. Specific Teaching Artist Duties Include:

- Planning, preparing for and leading daily activities
- Assisting in the planning of integrated lessons.
- Utilizing the resources of the theatre to provide a creative and stimulating environment for campers.
- Providing additional supervision to students during lunch
- Directing the final performance and providing closure after each session

Specific Intern Duties Include:

- Supporting lead teaching artists in daily activities
- Assisting in the needs of the Administrative Staff, Specialty Teachers and Lead Teachers
- Organizing supplies and taking inventory of supplies needed
- Opportunity to teach mini-focus classes in skills such as vocal projection, stage presence, improvisation and other theatre/arts skills as determined by the skill sets of the staff
- Providing additional supervision to students during lunch
- Assisting in the final performances and after each session

We are also looking for specialty teachers in the areas of musical theatre dance and performance, musical direction, and film/video editing.

Time Commitment: Camp Showbiz classes run from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., June 10, 2019 to August 23, 2019. All major scheduling conflicts (vacations, alternative employment, etc.) must be noted within the original application to be honored without a deduction in pay. Ideal candidates would be able to commit for the entire summer session of 11 weeks. **Qualifications:** Applicants should have a background or interest in theatre or theatre education. Candidates with formal education in Theatre or experience with teaching, writing curriculums, directing, or film/photo editing are highly valued. **Stipend:** Summer Teaching Artists/Interns receive a stipend for the entire summer. All summer staff is paid bi-weekly
