SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:

The Magik Theatre seeks Artists in Residence to be a part of a cohort of teachers who work at our downtown location or at our partner locations throughout San Antonio.

The Magik Theatre holds classes and camps year round. These programs take place at The Magik Theatre, schools, and community organizations. We teach theatre in order to transform lives. Using a curriculum based on Social Emotional Learning, we build community, foster joy, uplift diversity, and increase literacy across multiple subject areas. Our theatre classes provide a safe space for students who have experienced trauma to express themselves in a healthy way through drama activities.

We are looking for Teaching Artists to collaborate with our community partners who are dedicated to Theatre Education and have a passion for students who have experienced trauma to help build confidence and explore the world of theatre.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the guidance of the Director of Education and Classes and Camps Manager, Artists in Residence will:

- Collaborate with Magik staff and community partners to create an ideal learning environment for students and participants.
- Create and/or implement lessons that support social and emotional development through theatre arts instruction.
- Gather appropriate supplies.
- Share lesson plans in accordance with Magik theatre policy
- Submit participant attendance and sign in sheets, and other documents in a timely manner in accordance with the Administrative deadlines.
- Adhere to Magik's and organizations guidelines & policies and to those of the facility, reporting any incidents or problems.
- Act as a positive role model to students, Magik staff, organization and fellow Teaching Artists.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Accepted Artists in Residence will be highly skilled in at least one of the following theatre arts disciplines: acting, improvisation, playwriting, movement, vocal production, technical theatre production, or world theatre.
- Experienced at guiding students to workshop, UIL, or full-scale culminating presentations.
- Proficient in curriculum building and teaching in several types of settings (additional professional development and support will be provided).
- Experienced at working with students from diverse backgrounds and belief systems
- Familiarity with working in trauma based organizations or environments (additional professional development and support will be provided).
- Teaching Artists will go through a Background check, CPR/First Aid training, Curriculum and Trauma training & Covid testing.
