**SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:** Teaching Artists will instruct grade 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> secondary students in area public schools classrooms Monday thru Friday for 45-92 minute blocks of time not to exceed 16 hours a week. Teaching Artists must be able to attend a one-day mandatory training (Date TBD), follow a curriculum according to guidelines, and instruct classes independently.

**PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Deliver excellent theatre arts education to secondary school students utilizing the Magik Theatre Arts Curriculum as well as meeting the curriculum needs of the San Antonio Independent School District.
- Assists the Director of Education with administrative duties, and communications regarding the Residency.
- Corresponds with staff and administrators at The Magik Theatre and the assigned school.
- Assists in evaluation of existing programs and logistics and suggests methods to improve program and service delivery.
- All other duties as assigned.

**REQUIRED:**

The ideal candidate will have:

- Experience teaching and/or working with children in this specific age group.
- Have experience writing and executing curriculum
- Have a background in theatre, music, dance or education.

**TIME COMMITMENT:** In addition to specific class schedules (TBD), Resident Teaching Artists are expected to commit to a one-day mandatory training (Date TBD) and attend meetings with the Director of Education. Some classes will require an end-of-semester sharing which may fall outside of the typical instructional day.
