Live theatre creates transformational experiences for young people - something that many children have had less access to due to the pandemic. The pandemic has shown us that in-person, tangible experiences are crucial to understanding the world around us, which directly correlates with our sense of compassion, identity, curiosity, and imagination.

We are pleased to open 2022 with *The Snowy Day and Other Stories*. Based on the books by Ezra Jack Keats, these stories were the first books for young people that featured a black character as the protagonist. First published in 1962, *The Snowy Day* has never been out of print and is the most checked out book of all time at the New York Public Library.

Playwright Jerome Hairson has done a beautiful job of capturing the magic of the books while crafting a story that shows us the wonder of a child exploring the world. What I love the most about these stories is seeing black children and families in situations that we all can relate to. It is not about oppression. It is about togetherness and growth.

At Magik Theatre, we know that theatre for young people can help shape the world in the way we hope for it to be. Ezra Jack Keats shared that sentiment when he said, "if we could see each other exactly as the other is, this would be a different world."

ABOUT THE SNOWY DAY AND OTHER STORIES FROM DARCELL BIOS' NOTES

This show comprises so much in under an hour. We are afforded the opportunity to witness an African American child, simply be. Untroubled, burdenless, and safe from any reality that is unnatural in the exploration process of growing up. I find it no coincidence that from 1962 to 1969, Ezra Jack Keats created books filled with happy endings for Black Children.

Tamir Rice met tragedy for playing in the park on a snowy day (2014); Emmit Till met tragedy for allegedly whistling (1955); Treyvon Martin met tragedy wearing a hooded coat whilst on his way home with skittles and tea (2012). All of these children had birthdays they could no longer look forward to and parents who could no longer celebrate with them.

However, in this show we see all of these scenarios be as they should: pleasant and filled with fountains of fascination. We watch the main character (Peter), in awe of the snow, surprised at the sounds and imprints that the snow is capable of. Once mastering winter, he grasped how to whistle to impress his dog. Peter expands his imagination, creating scenarios with his best friend at the neighborhood hideout. Perhaps, most frustratingly, penning the perfect invite to his birthday party.

My hope is that you see Peter as yourself, as your child, as a child, and like his signature red snowsuit, hug yourself and your children warmly. I dedicate this show to the parents of African American children, who wish they could do the same.

Anthony Runfola (Artistic Director) is in his second season with Magik and is excited to be leading the company into its bright future.

His directing credits at Magik include Maddi's Fridge, Snow White, Ella Enchanted, and Señor *Tortuga*. Other recent productions include *The* Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe, Wonderland: Alice's Rock and Roll Adventure, Goodnight Moon,

Eric and Elliot, The Neverending Story, and the world premieres of Interrupting Vanessa and Rock the Presidents (national tour). His production of Schoolhouse Rock Live! will be on its second national tour throughout 2021 and '22. He has been a guest artist at theatres and colleges throughout the country including Black Theatre Troupe, Actors Theatre of Phoenix, Teatro Bravo, Stray Cat Theatre, Phoenix Theatre, Gammage/ASU Public Events, Scottsdale and Mesa Community Colleges, Geva Theatre Center, and Seattle Children's Theatre.

Prior to arriving at Magik, Anthony was the Director of Production at Childsplay in Tempe, Arizona, where he oversaw the production of over 150 plays and musicals during his 20-year tenure. Additionally, he led the development of El Puente Festival and was a founding co-chair of the company's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion committee. In 2010, he founded the Sustainable Stagecraft Initiative researching and developing sustainable practices for theatrical production. He has been invited to speak on the subject at conferences throughout the nation.

He is a founding member of Upstairs Theatre Company in Tucson, AZ and served as the company's artistic director until 2001. In 2015, he was accepted into the inaugural cohort of ArtEquity. Theatre Communications Group selected him as one of 50 U.S. theatre practitioners to participate in I Am Theatre, a web series celebrating pivotal moments in the lives of theatre-makers. He is an alumnus of the Lincoln Center Theater Directors Lab and Director's Lab West at the Pasadena Playhouse.

Along with his family, he is a recent transplant to San Antonio (arriving in 2020) and is looking forward to *finally* getting to explore the city!

HOW MAGIK IS KEEPING YOU SAFE

- All Magik staff are fully vaccinated against Covid-19 and will wear masks at all times during your visit.
- Magik's HVAC system has been updated with a UV purification system to reduce all airborne pathogens.
- Portable air scrubbers are in place in the lobbies where patrons naturally congregate (such as near concessions)


