I'm going to Magik Theatre today!

Today, I'm going to Magik Theatre in San Antonio, Texas. I'm going to see a play or another live event!



When I Arrive

When I arrive, I will wait in line to enter with my family or group. It may be loud and crowded, but that is okay because this is a Sensory Inclusive location.



Tickets

I will purchase tickets at the box office or if I have already purchased tickets, I will pick them up at the box office.

Next, I will need to have my ticket scanned. Soon I will be inside enjoying the event!



Getting a KultureCity Sensory Bag

If I would like, I can borrow a KultureCity Sensory Bag. They are available at the Box Office and Merchandise Stand.



What's in a KultureCity Sensory Bag?

There are items in the KultureCity Sensory Bag that will help me feel calm. I can use the noise-canceling headphones if I find it too loud. I can use the fidget tools in my KultureCity Sensory Bag to help me stay calm and enjoy the event with my group or family.



Staff

If I have any questions or need help, I can ask a staff member. They wear a black shirt with Magik Theatre name tags.



Snacks and Drinks

If I get hungry or thirsty during the event, I can visit the concession stand. There are many food and drink options here. I can also bring a snack into the theatre.



Restroom

If I need to go to the restroom, I can ask a friendly staff member where the closest one is located.



Headphone Zone

Magik Theatre is considered a Headphone Zone as many people will be very excited. There will be loud cheering and applause. I might feel most comfortable wearing my headphones while I'm visiting.



Finding my Seat

There are many seats at Magik Theatre. If I need help finding my seat, I can ask a friendly staff member. The lights will be on during this time. There might be noise as other audience members look for their seats as well.



Before the Show

When the lights dim, this means the show is about to start.

A Magik Theatre staff member will come on stage and make a few announcements. Then, the actors will come on stage and tell a story through song and dance.



During the Show

During the show, there might be some audience participation. I can participate if I want, but I don't have to. There might also be some clapping. I can clap or I can cover my ears if it gets too loud.



Quiet Area

During the show, I can play with my fidget gadgets, put on headphones or even take a break in the designated Quiet Area if I start to feel overwhelmed. I should find a friendly staff member to help me locate the closest one. Here I can recharge and rejoin the fun once I feel ready.



After the Show

At the end of the show, the actors will bow, answer a few questions, and wave goodbye.



Leaving

There may be many people leaving Magik Theatre at the same time when the event is over, but I can take my time. I should also stay with my group or family and leave together.
