Show Synopsis

Based on a real story set in the 1940s, Tomas and his family are migrant workers from Texas who travel to a small town in Iowa for work. While in Iowa, Tomas meets a kind librarian who helps teach him English and reading. Through his knowledge of reading and writing in English grows. Tomas gains the confidence to stand up for himself and his education, and is therefore able to push past the barriers and live a successful life.

Character Synopses

Male Actor (This role has been cast)

This actor plays a variety of roles but mostly focusing on the part of young Tomas. A brilliant and imaginate child of a migrant worker family. He loves reading and writing and has a thirst for knowledge.



<u>Female Actor</u> (Hispanic)

This actor plays a variety of roles including The Library Lady, Tomas's mother, and others. The Library Lady is German woman who works at the local library and helps young Tomas with reading english. Tomas and The Library lady share things about their respective cultures and languages and build and unlikely friendship.

When Wolfgang, the "greatest actor in the world," sets out to perform his one-man version of the Red Riding Hood story, he's interrupted by a delivery driver with a mysterious package and plenty of opinions about how the story should go. Together, they jump into a fast and funny retelling of the classic fairy tale, playing every role and discovering unexpected surprises along the way. This clever, energetic, family-friendly show celebrates courage, bravery, and the strength that comes from working together.

Character Synopses

Wolfgang

Wolfgang is a very serious actor with very serious intentions for their one-man performance of Red Riding Hood. They are stubborn when Delivery tries to interrupt the show and make wild changes. Wolfgang is comically cunning and dramatic, but by the end of the show, they show their soft side. Delivery

Delivery is a package delivery driver who walks into the middle of Wolfgangs' production, interrupting it. Delivery then decided that they want to be in the show, despite Wolfgangs disapproval. Delivery often interrupts the story and refuses to play the part as Wolfgang wants, causing comedic tension.

Shermy/Male Swing

Charlie Browns friend. Shermy is good at sports but is disappointed in his role for the Christmas Show.

Patty/Female Swing

Patty is friends with Violet and often joins in on the chorus of insults directed at Charlie Brown.
